• The source of inspiration of NSI:

- First country to implementation the Grenoble model of the « industries industrialisantes »
- Forward and backward linkages
- Very keen to diversify its economy the oil depletion syndrome

- Strong industrial base but a week industrial strategy
- Need to uplift its industrial capacities and innovation (GII rnaking)
- Keen to set up a competitive activities in the propsect of oil depletion

Strategy adopted

- Two phases process
- Phase1/ A national Globelics preparatory seminar (16-19 April 2012) held in Algiers
- Phase 2/ the Academy destined to North and West Africa (April 2013) in Algiers

Phase1: the national Globelics STI Seminar (Algiers 16-19 April 2012)

- Theme : Emerging innovation systems and practices in Algeria : what prospects for take off
- Both Doctoral students and researchers
- Nearly one hundred applications received (80 relevant preselected)
- Heavily Based on empirical work and on the entreprises (all sectors oil, ICT, mechanical, services) and agriculture
- 33 papers were selected on full-paper basis:
- About 10 to be proposed to the Algiers academy training session

Funding and support

- Fully funded by the Institute and the help of some sponsors
- Government support (Presidency)
- Prize award of best papers
- 6 papers in Arabic, 4 in English 70 in French
- 40% women applicants
- All students are registered in Algerian Universities
- Collaboration of the Ministry of Higher Education and research

The Globelics Globelics Academy in Algiers

- Training session for Doctoral students
- Covering North and West Africa (French dominant but english accepted)
- Simultaneous interpretation provided
- Dates : 16 to 28 April 2014
- 35 to 40 participants
- Teachers from eminents members of Globelics/Africalic community (Francophone and anglophone)

- ISGP funds food , accomodation and local transportation (Globelics/Donnors for flight tickets)
